### Invitation to Enter

*The Buckhorn Festival of the Arts Art Competition, invites entries from people who reside or vacation in Ontario.*

### The objectives of the Art Competition are:

- To encourage and develop the creativity of visual art talent in teens (age 13—19 years), adults and seniors;
- To recognize and support the further development of artistic ability;
- To provide artists with an opportunity to learn from the experience of being judged by a team of art professionals;
- To showcase individual creative style, design and techniques.

### Sale of Work

This is an opportunity for you to have your art purchased and appreciated in the home of someone who visits the festival. The artist will be notified of the sale by telephone. Buckhorn Festival of the Arts will deduct 20% commission from all sales. The festival will issue a cheque to the artist (80% of the sale price less applicable taxes) by Sept. 30, 2020.

### Rules of Entry (Please read carefully)

1. Each artist may submit only one piece for the competition. It must have been completed within the past 12 months.
2. The piece of art must have the artist's name, phone, city of residence,

medium and title of artwork on the back or on an index card attached to the back of the artwork.

3. The artwork must be original in concept, design, and execution.
4. The Entry Form must be completed and attached with \$5.00 fee.
5. An entry must not have been entered in previous Buckhorn Art Competitions.
6. **Artwork must be framed, ready for hanging complete with wire, AND MUST NOT EXCEED A PERIMETER OF 120" INCLUDING FRAME. Ensure the frame chosen is suitable for the competition and that your work is securely attached.**
7. Advertising, and commercial art installations are not eligible.
8. Competition Organizers reserve the right to refuse any entry for any reason, and will, if the above prerequisites are not met.
9. The decisions of the judges are final.
10. Entries can be picked up at the conclusion of the Festival on Sunday August 16, between 4 & 5 pm. *No exceptions or early pick-up.*

Entries are to be picked up at the conclusion of the festival on Sunday, August 16 between 4 and 5 pm only. Be sure to retain your original receipt: You must present it in order to reclaim your artwork.

### Competition Classes

**Teenage Class**- Any artist, any medium, age 13 to 19 years old.

**Novice Class** - Any artist, any medium, 19 years or older who has been painting for two years or less.

**Hobby Artist Class** - Any artist, 19 years or older who does not sell or show their work in galleries, juried or professional art festivals or shows, does not teach art professionally and is not considered a commercial artist.

**Open Class** - Any artist who has had showings of their work in galleries, art festivals and shows, (excluding the 2018 Buckhorn Festival of the Arts) or who may teach art. Open Class includes Acrylic, Oil, Pastel/Charcoal: Pen&Ink; Pencil, Digital, Mixed Media, Photography, Graphic.

### Judging

The Judging panel will include representatives from the arts and education fields and will be chaired by the Buckhorn Fine Art Competition Committee. Entries are evaluated against a set of criteria that has been established for the class in which they are entered.

Judging will be done in private prior to the opening of the festival.

### Ribbons & Awards

**Teenage Class** - 2nd & 3rd place winners receive Rosette ribbon, 1st place winner receives Rosette ribbon and prize.

**Novice Class** - 2nd & 3rd place winners receive Rosette ribbon, 1st place winner receives Rosette ribbon and prize.

**Open and Hobby Classes** - Rosette ribbons awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners in each category

**Best of Show** (selected from 1st place winners in Open and Hobby categories) - winner receives Rosette ribbon and prize

**Future Promise Award** (selected from winners in Teenage and Novice categories) - winner receives Rosette ribbon and prize

**People's Choice Award** (selected from all categories by Festival attendees) - winner receives Rosette ribbon and prize

### Announcement of Winners

Winners will be notified by telephone. Winners agree that their names will be announced on Sunday at the Festival, printed in a Buckhorn Community Centre newsletter as well as on the website after the 2020 Buckhorn Festival of the Arts. Ribbons and Awards will be presented on Sunday August 16th at 3:30pm in Festival Park. Winners will be asked to provide photo for promotional purposes only.
